Lead Service Line Inventory Survey
January 15, 2025

A comprehensive Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) is required as part of the Environmental Protection Agency's plan to eliminate lead service lines as per EPA regulations and Washington State Governor's Directive 16-06.

Whidbey Water Services (WWS) recently sent a letter to each homeowner asking for information regarding the service line from your meter to your residence. Unfortunately, the letter stated that there was a survey in your most recent billing statement. This was in error; the survey is at the bottom of the letter you recently received from WWS. You are being asked to fill out this survey and return it to WWS at the following address:

Your cooperation in filling out the survey will reduce the costs that would otherwise be incurred if WWS needed to visit the property to determine if your water service line is made of lead. According to WWS, if your home was built after 1986, you do not have lead service pipes running from your meter to your residence and there will be no need for WWS to investigate. However, you still need to complete and return the survey. If you do not know when your home was built, or don't know if you have a lead service line, make a note on the survey that you do not know.
